

TERMS and CONDITIONS SHELL InGenious Competition 3

Article 1 General

1. These terms and conditions (“Competition Conditions”) apply to the Energy Future School programme (the “Competition”), which is organised by Shell Nederland B.V., having its registered office in The Hague at Carel van Bylandtlaan 30 (“Shell Nederland”), and EUN Partnership aisbl, having its registered office in Brussels at rue de Treves 61 (“EUN”), commonly referred to as The Organisers, under the ECB - InGenious project (“InGenious”).

InGenious is the European Coordinating Body in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) Education co-funded by the European Commission under the 7th Framework Programme for Research and Development, and representing a consortium of industry and education stakeholders (as per the contract number with the EC 266622). InGenious promotes industry-school collaboration to reinforce young Europeans' interest in science education and careers and thus address anticipated future skills gaps within the European Union.

2. The Energy Future Competition period starts in May 2014, with the publication of the competition notice and ends on October 31 2014, by awarding the overall winner of the competition. Applications will be accepted from 1 September 2014 until 22 October 2014 at the latest. No submissions will be accepted after 22 October 2014.

Article 2 Participating countries

All 28 EU Member States (Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, United Kingdom) plus FYROM, Israel, and Turkey.

Article 3 Entry rules

Teachers from all primary and secondary schools from the above countries, are welcome to participate and submit their entry, and can do so until 22 October 2014 by midnight GMT, through the online submission tool that will be made available on the website <http://www.energyfuture.nl/>.

Teachers participate in the Competition and submit their entry together with their class. Each class is allowed to participate only once. To enter the Competition, participants are asked to watch the eight episodes of the film Energy Future and to answer the accompanying interactive tests related to each episode.

The 8 episodes will be published on the InGenious website (InGenious-science.eu), starting from May 2014 with the first episode. Every two weeks a new episode will be added so that teachers and their class can get familiar with the topics addressed.

From 1 September 2014, at about 10.00 a.m. (NL time), a link will be published from the InGenious website to the competition tool available on <http://www.energyfuture.nl/en/tests>

Each video will be accompanied by a related test (a set of up to twelve questions related to the topics and information presented in the episode).

To enter the Competition, participants shall take all eight tests and answer all questions. Each correct answer will earn up to 5 points, depending on the rapidity in providing the answer as shown in the test timer. There will be a maximum total of 380 points.

After completing the tests, to finalise the entry, participants will be requested to enter contact details and information about their school correctly and accept these Competition Conditions. This will allow them to be contacted for any notifications regarding the competition winner.

The Organisers, reserve the right to disqualify any competition entrants if they contradict these Competition Conditions (or if Shell Nederland and EUN suspect that this is the case), if entrants provide incomplete, inaccurate, misleading or unlawful information or otherwise act illegally towards The Organisers or third parties.

No correspondence or other exchange will be entered into with respect to the results of the Competition.

Article 4 Winners selection and prizes

One European winning school will be identified and automatically selected based on their performance (most correct answers) on the technical platform where the tests and competition run. If more than one school is in first place, having gained the same number of points, the first prize will be raffled among the schools in question. If a raffle is necessary, it will be organised in an even-handed manner.

The school will be notified and contacted about the award delivery by 31 October 2014 at the latest.

The prize offered under this Competition is a voucher of the value of 1000 Euro (excluding VAT), which will be used for a visit of the winning classroom to a local science museum. The Competition school winning the first prize will have to pay for the bus rental, museum entrances and any other cost related to the prize, not exceeding 1000 Euro, in advance. EUN will reimburse the school concerned for a value of up to max

1000 Euros (after EUN has received a correct justifications).

The visit to the science museum, and the reimbursement of the related costs will have to be finalised within the academic year 2014-2015, latest on the 30 June 2015.

More detailed (financial and justification) conditions will be shared by EUN with the winning school. If for any reason the first prize is refused by the winning school, the winner will not be entitled to alternative prizes.

Article 5 Privacy Policy

Competition entrants are required to supply their correct and full name and email address. Inaccurate or incomplete entries will be disregarded.

The personal details will only be used to contact the competition entrants of winning schools. All personal details that The Organisers obtain from competition entrants as part of this Competition will be dealt with confidentially and in accordance with the Dutch Data Protection Act.

The contact details supplied by the competition entrants will be collected on behalf of Shell Nederland by BrandBase B.V. By entering the Competition participants agree that their data may be used to contact a winner about the Competition.

Furthermore, by registering and uploading answers to the Competition, the contestants

- Agree that the Organizers shall have the right to make the content freely available for educational purposes on the web, CD-ROM or in any other media format for a period of three years starting from the date of the close of entries for the Competition.
- declare that all identifiable individuals in their entry consented: to the use of their performance, the submission of the content in this competition, and the use of the content by the Organizer for educational and promotional purposes in all media formats, including the web, for a period of three years from the date of the close of

entries for the Competition.

- declare that the individuals who have provided content for their submission will sign all necessary documents granting the Organiser, if required by it, the rights free of charge to use the content as indicated above
- Declare their agreement that the Organiser may freely use this presentation in all media formats in its promotional activities of the award. The Organiser shall have complete discretion as to how they want to claim and exercise these rights.

Agreement with the winning school in case of victory, will be organised in order for the organisers to use pictures from the visit to the science museum awarded, for communications purposes.

Article 6 Liability, applicable law and dispute resolution

By submitting an application, competition participants will be deemed to have accepted and be bound by the Competition Conditions which will be interpreted in accordance with Dutch law and subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Dutch courts.

The Organisers and any assistants and/or third parties engaged by them are not liable for any direct or indirect loss or damage arising from or otherwise related to this Competition or the visit to the local museum (including loss or damage resulting from the prizes made available by the competition).

Neither the Organisers nor the assistants and/or third parties engaged by them can be held responsible for disruptions to the power supply, communication connections or hardware or software of the Organisers or third parties that impair or delay participation.

Although the Organisers have managed the website(s) and organised the Competition with utmost care, the information provided and/or shown may be incomplete or contain

inaccuracies. The Organisers cannot be held liable for any printing, spelling or similar errors in any material publicised by the Organisers of any nature whatsoever, and these cannot in any way constitute grounds for imposing any obligation on the Organisers.

The Organisers are not responsible or liable for any additional expenses and/or costs that the winners may have to incur in connection with entering this Competition, and with acceptance, use or misuse of the prizes.

By accepting the prize, a winner agrees to hold Shell Nederland or its affiliates and EUN harmless against any and all claims and liability arising out of the award of, the use or misuse of any prize. Where the law implies warranties, which cannot be excluded, Shell Nederland's or EUN's liability for breach of those warranties is limited to resupplying the prize (or paying for the costs thereof), where this is permitted by law. A winner assumes all liability for any injury or damage caused, or claimed to be caused by participation in this promotion or use or redemption of any prize.

The Organisers reserve the right at all times to suspend, change, cancel or end the Competition, at sole discretion, without prior notice and without being liable to pay any compensation to participants. The Organisers' decision is final in every situation including any not covered above and no correspondence will be entered into.

Article 7 Final provisions

The Organisers reserve the right to end, interrupt or change the Competition and/or to change the Competition Conditions and/or Competition products/prizes unilaterally at any time, without prior notice, if the circumstances so require, without being liable for any compensation to the participants.

If one or more provisions of these Competition Conditions are declared null and void, the Organisers will stipulate a substitute provision that is not null and void or voidable

and whose objective and purpose are as close as possible to the objective and purpose of the provision that is null and void.
